

### Bloomingdale Association: New Year, New Name; Same Great Association

Bloomingdale residents are lucky to have a great neighborhood association, which was chartered in 1980. Its purpose has always been to promote neighborhood harmony while protecting property values, and through the years of growth in the community, the Association has maintained that goal as well as providing community events year-round.

In fall 2020, the Bloomingdale Homeowners Association (BHA) officially changed its name to the Bloomingdale Neighborhood Association (BNA).

President Suzy Watts and Vice President Sean Donahue are both excited about the BNA's future.

According to Donahue, "The name change will allow us to expand our coverage to a larger area and encompass more communities that we can assist and bring together."

Donahue also noted that COVID-19 has made an impact on just about every aspect of life. "Disappointingly, there has been less interaction with the community, but the Association has continued to work hard to host activities that will be fun yet provide a safe environment for all."

The Association helps link neighbors to county resources such as Code Enforcement. Board members attend county meetings and report back zoning, traffic and police reports that impact Bloomingdale. The Association recently worked with the district and county regarding the road improvements on Natures Way. It also worked with the Bloomingdale Special District to get common sidewalks repaired; a project now completed.

It is also about bringing the residents together. Watts said, "The BNA has always acted as a neighborhood association encompassing a voluntary group of residents trying to promote Bloomingdale through fun activities like Trunk or Treat and Santa Parade."

This is an organization that can collectively speak for all residents and businesses in the Bloomingdale area as a positive force for change.

"We have an amazing office manager Joy (Boisselle), who usually knows the answer or finds it out for our neighbors," noted Watts.

Boisselle is also the editor of the Gazette, providing the community with local news. Students are supported by providing volunteer activities for service hours and there is an annual BNA scholarship.

Santa's recent tropical visit to Bloomingdale was so popular that Watts said that they hope to have a neighborhood drive-through Easter Bunny Parade. Plans are also underway for a parade/motorcade to honor Bloomingdale's football team, which made it to state semifinals for the first time.

### Live Christmas Trees

Curbside pickup of live Christmas trees is available by following these steps:

- · Remove all decorations, lights, and tinsel
- Cut the tree into sections no larger than 4-feet long and 6-inches in diameter
- Place curbside on your regular yard waste collection day

Drop off live trees at one of the following Yard Waste Processing Facilities, after removing all decorations, lights, and tinsel:

- 346 Falkenburg Road in Tampa
- 13000 U.S. Highway 41 in Gibsonton
- 8001 W. Linebaugh Ave. in Tampa

### **Holiday Lights**

- · Strings of holiday lights may be safely disposed of in the gray garbage cart or recycled as electronics at any of the County Community Collection Centers for no additional fee.
- Pre-lit trees should be placed in the regular trash.

### **Holiday Ornaments and Decorations**

Holiday decorations and ornaments, including pre-lit and artificial trees, should be discarded as trash if the items can't be donated


### Wrapping Paper and Cards

- Greeting cards and wrapping paper, as long as it is free of ribbons, foil, and other non-paper items, can be recycled by placing loose in the curbside blue recycling cart.
- Gift bags, tissue paper, ribbons and bows are NOT recyclable in the cart.

### Plastic Bags & Wrap

- Plastic bags, bubble wrap, and film cannot be recycled in your curbside blue cart
- Clean and dry plastic bags and film can be recycled at participating supermarkets in special bins located near the store entrance
- Loose and soiled bags, plastic film, shrink wrap, and bubble wrap should be placed in the trash cart

### What Hillsborough County buyers and sellers need to know

2020 was a year of multiple offers, hand sanitizer, a large number of buyers, lack of listings and parking lot closings.

Just look at these Hillsborough County single family home statistics:

**Buyers are still out in full force.** Most of my buying customers have been from out of state. I also had past customers move into larger homes due to homeschooling, home office needs and outdoor entertainment space. Per Greater Tampa Association of Realtors MLS, the price range most in demand for 2020 was \$200,000-\$300,000.

**Interest rates are still low.** As more people file for unemployment, however, mortgage lenders may tighten lending standards, subsequently driving up rates – or delayed demand could push rates down further. Potential buyers can prepare for homeownership by understanding their budget, building a good credit history, and getting prequalified for a mortgage.

**Home tours look a little different.** In person showings are still offered, potential buyers can expect quicker tours and may be asked to take extra precautions, such as removing shoes, using hand sanitizer and refraining from touching items in the home.

Many sellers have offered virtual tours of their homes through pre-recorded videos or live video streams. In fact, according to a recent NAR survey on the pandemic's impact on real estate, three in five REALTORS® said they are guiding buyers through virtual home tours.



### **Happy New Year!**

As we leave 2020 behind, I want to recap some of the positives from last year.

### New Landscape Contractor

We began 2020 by replacing our landscape and maintenance contractor. Your Green Team (YGT) brought more effective practices that achieved immediate results. Much of the improved look is due to an irrigation technician on-property full time. When irrigation issues are identified, YGT can have them repaired same day, sometimes within the hour.

### Sidewalk Repairs and Natures Way Improvements

The District worked with the County to complete sidewalk repairs and correct associated damages. The coordination efforts were led by our property manager, Rick Pitrowski, who initially mapped out the hundreds of individual damage locations three years ago. Rick also pushed the County to use our irrigation specialist to mitigate unnecessary destruction of water lines during

digging. Sidewalk repairs were completed throughout the District, giving us a more enjoyable walk through the community.

New medians and bike lanes installed along Natures Way provide better options for cyclists and a safer drive.

We will begin installing annuals and perennials in the spring. The poinsettias we added for the holidays have been a big hit - look for those again next December.

We conducted a successful experiment using ground cover to replace struggling turf along Natures Way. Doing so has created a beautiful contrast and also curbed the destructive parking in the turf. A second phase of ground cover planting will be completed in the spring across the street. Also to discourage parking on the turf, delineators were installed at the corner of Natures Way and Culbreath. We are hoping the delineators will be temporary. I encourage those of you who currently park on the turf to instead park on the side of Culbreath, south of Natures Way. This will cut down on



turf damage and destruction that could result in individual residents being charged.

### Rebranding Project

Our entryway and rebranding project was slowed down due to permit requirements and COVID-19. The District is scheduling an application review with the County to review our plan for the Erindale/Lithia Pinecrest entrance. Although much delayed, we hope to finally break ground later this year.

### Welcome, Lee Raschke

Finally, we added another new member to the Board of Trustees. Lee Raschke has been a Bloomingdale resident for nearly 17 years and is a Captain with the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Department. Welcome aboard, Lee!


