## Military Retiree Finds Fountain of Youth In Bodybuilding

When Colonel (Retired) Roland Tiso, Jr. retired from his military career, he wasn't content to let his fitness decline.


"Following my mandatory retirement from the Army in 2004, I chose to continue to serve as a defense contractor. I looked for the toughest assignments that took me back to the Middle-East and ultimately back to Iraq and Afghanistan. I knew that my assignments would be both mentally and physically demanding, so I pursued a very demanding physical fitness program while I worked at US Central Command at MacDill AFB."

A member of Campo YMCA since 2005, he takes his workouts very seriously. He had always been an avid body builder, and in 2010 on a friend's suggestion, he decided to return to his passion and became a competitor in the Masters Level Bodybuilding.

Tiso said, "So I gave it a try and entered my first competition in June 2010 and placed second on the Masters 50-Year-Old Light-Heavy Division. I was hooked. I use bodybuilding more as a venue to stay healthy and fit than for anything else."



He has won many subsequent championships throughout Florida since then. Turning 70 on Feb. 2, and he proudly states that his doctor has told him he has the medical profile of a 25-year-old Olympic athlete. He takes no medications.



"Bodybuilding is a great hobby and I meet a lot of good people," Tiso noted.

Most recently, he won the Iron Bay Bodybuilding Classic Masters 60 Championship in Tampa in September 2020, and plans to compete in the Masters 70-year-old Division in the Florida State Championships in 2021.

Colonel Tiso entered the Army in 1969 and graduated from the Virginia Military Institute. He was commissioned an Infantry Second Lieutenant in 1973. His 35-year military career included command of two infantry companies in Korea and the United States, the 1st Battalion, 508th Airborne Infantry in Panama, and United States Task Force Sinai, Multi-National Force & Observers in Egypt. He was one of the primary planners of the Iraq War Plan and also served as the Executive Officer to the Commander of U.S. Central Command (General A.C. Zinni, USMC), 1998-2000.

A graduate of the U.S. Army War College, the Command & General Staff and the Armed Forces Staff Colleges, Tiso also held infantry assignments in Korea and throughout South America, the Middle East and Central and South Asia. He saw combat action in Somalia, Iraq, and Afghanistan. He holds the Combat Infantryman, Master Parachutist, Pathfinder and Air Assault Badges, the Ranger Tab, and numerous individual decorations for meritorious service and heroism in combat including awards from five foreign nations. He is the only American to have received the Ukrainian Order of Valor and Honor for combat action in Iraq in 2003.

Tiso and his wife Judie have lived in their Bloomingdale home in The Greens since 1998. They have two daughters; Catherine Inzirillo who resides with her husband Michael; and Alexandra Argentine, who is married to her husband Per. They also recently welcomed their first grandchild, Lena Jean Inzirillo, born in July.

Although retired, Colonel Tiso is still fit to fight! He and those who serve in our military make our world a safer place to live.

I stand quietly (camera in hand) watching as the great blue heron strolls slowly down the path with its prize catch; a catfish tucked safely within its beak. It hangs on tightly to the fish, I imagine, preserving it for its next meal.

This is a place where nature is king. Circle B Bar Reserve is located in Lakeland, 50 minutes from Bloomingdale, but a world away.

Although any day at Circle B Bar Reserve is a good one, the Florida winters make this time of year exceptional. Circle B is a prime breeding area for many local and migrating species. Late winter is a great time to see nesting birds and maybe catch a glimpse of the babies.

This is not a zoo, and what you see depends on the season. No outing is ever the same. On my last trip to "The B" it was pretty quiet. Even a quiet day at Circle B provides you with enough inspiration for taking the perfect picture or just enjoying the natural side of Florida.

Circle B used to be a cattle ranch. Polk County and the Southwest Florida Water Management District acquired the property in December 2000. The reserve is 1,267 acres and with over six miles of trails, which are well marked and vary in length, you will actually pass through various types of ecosystems.

The Polk Nature Discovery Center is on property and is open to visitors. Be sure to bring your mask if you want to enter and visit the exhibits indoors or to use the rest rooms. It is also a good idea to carry it on the trails as some of them are narrow and you may prefer to have some extra protection even though you are outdoors.

I like to start my walk on Heron Hideout then turn down Marsh Rabbit Run to the Wading Bird Way. It wraps around to Eagle Roost and then to Alligator Alley which will take you back to the Discovery Center. This particular route is around four miles. Trail maps are available at the Discovery Center or online. The trails are well marked.

If you choose to visit, please leave your pets at home. Many alligators inhabit Lake Hancock and the trails are close to many waterways. Alligators do cross the paths (they have the right of way). Please respect their space and any other animal that may cross your path. If you are lucky enough, you may also see raccoons, otters, bobcats and wild boars.

Walk slowly so that you can spot the birds, butterflies or gators and turtles hidden almost right in front of you. Watch the birds sunning, preening and feeding. Listen to their songs. Take a few deep breaths; forget your cares if only for the present and just enjoy the view.

Circle B is free to visit and is located at 4399 Winter Lake Rd. in Lakeland. It is open daily from sunrise to sunset. For more information, visit www.polknature.com/explore/circle-b-bar-reserve.

Enjoy a few hours visiting Circle B Bar Reserve, which is located in Lakeland. This is one of the best places to commune with nature.








## Burns Artist Recreates Dali Masterpiece




