Bike Lane Markings Update Also Known as Share the Road with Cyclists

Florida law recognizes bicycles as vehicles, so cyclists have the same rights and responsibilities as someone legally operating a motor vehicle.

New bike markings on Bloomingdale streets including Natures Way and Culbreath Road are a visual reminder of this fact. Several sections of Natures Way now have dedicated bike lanes for cyclist use.

Other sections where there is not enough space for a dedicated lane are also marked with bike images to alert both motorists and cyclists to “share the road!”

The bottom line is to improve safety for everyone on the road.

Note: Joggers and pedestrians must stay on community sidewalks.

Fretting Over Taxes? Virtual Help is Available

HC Press Release

Hillsborough County resources continue to connect residents with free tax prep assistance and software access.

No doubt 2020 was a year like no other, but how will impacts of a global pandemic affect your income tax? Hillsborough County can help you answer that question. Free tax preparation assistance for individuals or families is available from the Hillsborough County Extension Service.

Here are ways Extension Service can assist:

If you need minimal assistance, complete a short form at https://ufl.qualtrics.com/jfe/form/SV_56L1QtcKlqdN9aK and you will receive access to the Extension Service free tax software program. This has no income limit and will allow you to prepare your income tax forms free and from the comfort of your home.

If you don't feel completely comfortable doing it all yourself and would like one-on-one remote assistance, you can make an appointment for a telephone or web conference chat. Internal Revenue Service (IRS) trained and certified volunteers will provide guidance as you complete the return using the same free tax preparation software. To schedule an appointment, contact Denise Kantak (813) 744-5519 ext. 54141.

You can receive help with questions relating to tax credits for items such as the Earned Income Tax Credit, Child Tax Credit, Saver's Credit, Recovery Rebate Credit, education credits, and the premium tax credit. Extension Service cannot offer tax guidance on rental income or tax depreciation.

Assistance is available through April 8.

The Hillsborough County Public Library Cooperative (HCPLC) has information on their website for access to free income tax preparation help through AARP and the United Way Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program. Appointments are limited and fill up quickly. Visit HCPLC.org/TaxPrepHelp for more information.

The Hillsborough County Capital Programs department completed the highly anticipated Lithia Pinecrest Intersection Improvement Project in 2020, improving traffic flow at the intersection and providing safe, reliable transportation options for all road users.

1. RZ-PD 21-0222

From the Bokors Corner Facebook page, Application RZ-PD 21-0222 at Bloomingdale Ave / Watson Rd is a request to modify and increase the number of townhomes to be built next to the Watson Glen neighborhood. The bottom line is an increase in townhome count from 63 to 90 and changing business uses for front parcels. Townhome access looks to be set for Watson Road only. Also included are four front Retail parcels with Parcel 3 to include a drive-thru coffee shop and bank.



2. RZ 21-0123

This application at Bell Shoals Road and Bloomingdale Avenue requests rezoning to PD for public storage uses and single-family lots. This is the current location of Bloomingdale Self-Storage.

The applicant is requesting to develop 4 buildings at a maximum of 32,000 square feet. Two of the buildings would be fully enclosed and two of the buildings would have a covered roof for RV/Boat storage and 3 single family homes. The proposed location is just 60 feet north of the intersection with Bloomingdale Ave. An access route would also be constructed on Bell Shoals Road.

Due to the pandemic, Festival officials have decided to forgo the headline entertainment this year. Masks will be required in all structures, including tents, stadiums and also on the rides. Social distancing is encouraged. If you are looking for something more creative, try a hamburger patty fried on a griddle and topped with strawberry mayonnaise, strawberry relish and sandwiched between two sweet strawberry donuts.

It's Strawberry Season! Visit these Local Farms that Offer U-Pick Strawberries

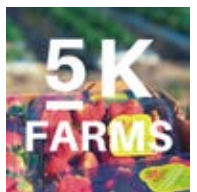

Crossing Guard Proves To Be A Hero

One special crossing guard, Kathleen Quinn, proved to be a hero for a young student at Cimino Elementary school last month.

Mom Mia Carlson was waiting for her daughter Madeline to cross the street at Culbreath Road and Natures Way Blvd. when a car swept by her, and continued through the intersection nearly striking her seven-year-old. Crossing Guard Quinn held up her stop sign, but when the driver did not slow down, she quickly jumped into action by pulling Madeline back to safety preventing what could have been a tragic situation.

According to Quinn, "I saw it coming and I put my arm out to make sure Madeline didn't get hit by the car. The car just kept going, and luckily no one was hurt."

Carlson ran over to Quinn and hugged her, extremely thankful for Quinn's swift response. "She [Quinn] goes toward the car with her stop sign and goes back for Madeline. As a mother, I was so thankful to her."

She now wishes she had had run after the car to get the plate number as it wasn't able to go far because of school traffic. The shocked Mom said, "So this car, couldn't wait five seconds, but then was stopped 50 yards away, still in front of my house, because of cars trying to turn into the school."

In the aftermath, Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office (HCSO) Sheriff Chad Chronister said, "Though she has only served two years as a crossing guard, she undoubtedly possesses the skills, and above all, the intuition needed to perform

this critical duty. Without hesitation, she stepped into harm's way to protect a child from a reckless driver. I am overwhelmed with pride to say she is a part of our team of dedicated crossing guards who treat every child on their route as their own and ensure they get to and from school safely."

Governor Ron DeSantis declared February 5 as Crossing Guard Appreciation Day, and the HCSO recognized the 295 men and women who help our children get to and from school safely every day.

As Carlson so eloquently put it, "You cannot rewind something like that. If something happens, you can't take that back. When you are driving, it's like a weapon. You have got to be careful."

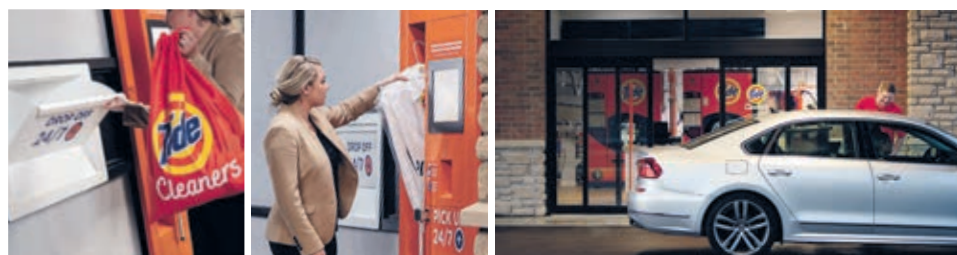
