A Message from President Tom Leech

I want to thank the community for your overwhelmingly positive responses to the 9/11 banners. We anticipate raising them each year around Labor Day in continued remembrance. For now, the 9/11 banners will remain up until just prior to Thanksgiving when the District will switch over to holiday banners. Coinciding with the banner change-out, the District will also rotate the annuals and install poinsettias for the holidays.

You may have noticed a slower pace of landscaping and common area maintenance. Our landscaping contractor, Your Green Team, is experiencing

staff shortages due to COVID, including several team members in quarantine. This has impacted the depth and frequency of service. The District is working with YGT to ensure that Bloomingdale retains its beauty and well-kept appearance as their workers recover.

On the subject of flowers and color, we are beginning the redesign of the landscaping beds at each of our entryways. The District developed a new plant palette that includes many new and colorful choices with which to enhance the outward appearance of Bloomingdale. YGT also expects to begin planting new turf and planting new creeping fig plants along sections of perimeter walls that were recently cleaned and painted. All of these new plantings will begin prior to Thanksgiving, which is the ideal time for these installations to take place.





Stalk & Vine Market Farm, located in Lithia on Highway 39, opens to the public on Friday, November 5. The 10-acre bio-intensive farm provides seasonal vegetables, herbs, peaches and flowers.

Patrick (Pat) and Carla Strickland started the farm in 2019. The property they secured already had about 80 peach trees and more than enough acreage for their planned small-scale operation, which offers naturally grown, chemical free produce.

Families and children of all ages are welcome to visit and see how food is grown. Carla keeps organic treats on hand for kids to enjoy when they visit. "The crops aren't the only thing we grow, relationships are cultivated here," Pat explained.

Pat is a native Floridian and an Army veteran. After serving in the Army, he started Timberline Landscaping Management and in the mid 90's, he founded Southern Bass Trails and the Southern Redfish Tour, a series of competitive fishing tournaments throughout Florida, which were televised on the Outdoor Channel and Sunshine Network. He retired from Brandon Ford in July 2020. Carla spent the greater portion of her working years managing and developing numerous multifamily communities in the Tampa Bay area.

Pat will tell you there is nothing easy about farming. Both him and Carla like the idea of providing healthy chemical free foods to people they love while enjoying the process and the time shared together.

Stalk & Vine has partnered with 15 Olives, an American family-owned business with the highest quality, USA grown (Florida and California) olive oil and flavored vinegars. They are farm to table, providing 100% clean oil made with real ingredients containing no additives, synthetics or food dyes. Other local offerings include






Her trip is scheduled for the summer of 2023. She is most looking forward to going to Disneyland Paris.

This summer we set our sights on visiting Kentucky. It is a state we may not have considered had our overseas travel plans not been canceled. We were glad to discover what makes it unique.

There is plenty to do and see in Kentucky. Mammoth Caves National Park can be visited year-round and it's not too far from the National Corvette Museum in Bowling Green where you can time hop from the 1950's to present day. Follow the Kentucky Bourbon Trail, mostly between Louisville and Lexington, sampling Kentucky's finest spirits at more than 35 distilleries. There is plenty for history buffs too. Mary Todd Lincoln's childhood home and Ashland, Henry Clay's Estate, both are located in Lexington.

Our road trip eventually took us to Lexington, which is considered the horse capital of the world. We signed up for a morning tour of local thoroughbred horse farms, where the breeding of these horses, many through the bloodlines of past derby winners, is big business. Our tour enabled us to get close up and personal with some of the beautiful mares and even their foal. The males can be a little rambunctious and we chose to keep our distance, but they are very impressive to see up close. The farms are multi-million dollar businesses and the grounds are impeccably kept.

On the recommendation of our tour guide Shaun Washington, we visited

internationally renowned Keeneland racing facility. It is open 24/7 and the public is welcome to come in for free to see the grounds. Early morning is the best time to go. While there, we got to see trainers working with their horses taking practice runs. One made sure to let us know that his horse had recently won the Breeders Cup, which made it a potential Derby racer.

Kentucky is probably best known for its annual Kentucky Derby Run for the Roses race, which is normally held the first Saturday in May at Churchill Downs in Louisville.

So it was on to Louisville. It is hard to imagine that one race a year has made this place so famous. You will need to visit the Kentucky Derby Museum in order to visit the grounds if it's not a race day. Admission includes a 30 minute walking tour of the lower grounds, but I highly recommend paying the extra \$20 for the 90 minute Behind the Scenes tour for fascinating stories

from the past. You will see where celebrities such as Tom Brady hang out. Queen Elizabeth and her entourage were welcomed in 2007 where they enjoyed the festivities from Millionaires Row. As I stood up there overlooking the beautiful grounds, I imagined donning my fancy hat with mint julep in hand.

Bloomingdale High School To Host Countywide Marching Band Performances

If you've ever been delighted to hear the Bloomingdale band from within the community or enjoyed watching them perform at a football game, mark your calendar for Saturday, November 6. On that date, Bloomingdale High School will host all the marching bands in Hillsborough County for the annual Florida Bandmasters Association Marching Music Performance Assessment (MPA). Admittance is \$8 and attendees can come throughout the day to watch the 27 high school marching bands perform.



Jon Sever, Bloomingdale's Director of Bands, encourages the community to come to the event. "The MPA will move to the other side of the county next year so come out to enjoy our community's youth and the culture music programs give them." Sever said.

Typically, a school hosts the event for two consecutive years, but last year the event was canceled due to Covid-19. Sever explained that makes this year unique: "Because of Covid last year, half of this year's band has not been to a marching evaluation. They are, however, doing fantastic and making some great music memories for members and fans alike."

Bloomingdale's Rajun' Bull Band has 177 members. They will perform a Southern Rock N' Soul show. It is a collection of classic and current songs from over five decades. Included in the medley are Sweet Home Alabama, House of the Rising Sun, and Wagon Wheel.

At MPAs, bands strive to perform at their very best. They perform in front a panel of judges. Two judges will assess musical performance, with a third judge grading the percussion section. Dance teams and flag corps will be graded by a judge for their contribution to the visual performance. Two more judges will assess the visual performance and the overall effect of the show.
