
What is the Bloomingdale Neighborhood Association?

The Bloomingdale Neighborhood Association (BNA), formerly called the Bloomingdale Homeowners Association, is a voluntary community organization. The organization covers 32 neighborhoods, 16 of which have mandated HOAs. The other 16 neighborhoods do not have an HOA. They are considered non-mandated HOA neighborhoods.

What does the Bloomingdale Neighborhood Association do for you?

The association's purpose is to promote neighborhood cohesion and harmony while protecting property values and the quality of life for residents. This is done in various ways. The BNA organizes neighborhood activities including community clean-up events, garage sales, celebrations, and holiday events. The BNA is a liaison with local government agencies, relaying pertinent information to residents and reporting county code violations when necessary. The BNA partners with local schools by providing students community service hours and a yearly scholarship opportunity. The BNA produces our community paper- this paper- The Bloomingdale Gazette.

The Bloomingdale Neighborhood Association is invaluable as it assists Bloomingdale residents with concerns and issues in their neighborhoods. For neighborhoods with HOAs, the BNA connects residents with their HOA management and ensures residents



know who to communicate with. For neighborhoods that do not have HOAs, the BNA works as a liaison to provide residents communication with Hillsborough County Government offices for code violation concerns and questions. The BNA assists with finding resources to help residents in all of the neighborhoods.



HOMETOWN HEROES

Walter Caldwell Ingram, Colonel, USA Ret.

"We served 26 years. We had 26 years... and we had a very exciting career. I always wanted to be in the Army. In high school they had a thing called NDCC, National Defense Cadet Corps. In college that's RTOC. I went to Texas Western College. It's called UTEP now- The University Texas El Paso- and that's where I met my bride. I was in ROTC and Claudia was a sponsor with a girls' drill team. I was lucky enough that she said yes.

I was always going to be in the military. From a kid, I always played Army. You know, like kids do. And watching it on television- I just always wanted to be solider.

I was in communications, okay. I wanted to produce The Big Picture. The Big Picture was stories about the military and mostly about what they did in WII. The Army did that. The Army produced this thing called the Big Picture. My goal was to be involved in that- the production, acting, whatever. I wanted to be part of The Big Picture. I found out that that wasn't exactly what the Signal Corps would be. I was lucky enough to enjoy ROTC and because of that I was selected for my commissioning. I could pick any branch I wanted to be because I was a distinguished military graduate. I picked the Army Signal Corps because the Signal Corps was the one that was responsible for producing The Big Picture. Okay. They no longer did that by the time I picked but I thought communications was an interesting field. Also, in ROTC in El Paso, I learned to fly through the ROTC program so I had my wings or half wings, actually. So, when I came in the Army, I wanted to fly. In 1968 we got married and we were assigned to Fort Gordon, which is the home of the Army Signal Corps. It's in Fort Gordon, Georgia. We went there and then we went to Fort Sill for advanced signal training and then we went to Fort Hood in Texas.

I no idea. I mean, ROTC treats you very well for the basics of what the military is about and the history. But, until I got to my platoon, I didn't really appreciate what an army signal officer would do. Luckily I had some good sergeants that took me under their wing and said, 'Ok, lieutenant, this is how we are going to run the platoon.' But most of the guys coming back out of Vietnam at that point and time, and in our culture at that point in time, we were pretty, uh, what do I want to say? The morale and discipline was real low because of Vietnam.

We flew some pretty classified missions back then. Now they're not classified. Anyway, I had a good time flying in Vietnam. I was young. I enjoyed flying. I enjoyed being responsible for communication. My first son was born while I was in Vietnam. Even though what we were doing in Vietnam probably could have been done a lot better... I came home and was not greeted well. I came back through Seattle to Denver and then I finally got home. Then everything was good again because I was with my family. We went back and forth between aviation assignments and signal assignments. I got back from Vietnam in 1971. I went over in 70, November of 70 and came back in November of 71, almost to the day. But, that was the start of my career."


LET'S HONOR BLOOMINGDALE'S HOMETOWN HEROES!

The Ingram brothers and their parents, Fred and Deanna Ingram, are giving to our community by spearheading the Hometown Heroes Project. Garret is a Senior and Joshua is a sophomore at Bloomingdale High School. Mason is a 5th grader at Cimino Elementary.

Our service members their families sacrifice much to protect our freedom. My dad, Fred Ingram, grew up as a military kid. He shares this about his experience, "I remember school and sporting events my dad missed due to his deployments. I was sad and sometimes feared for his safety. However, I was proud of my dad. He is my hero. He served in the Army from 1968 to 1993, as a signal officer a dual-rated aviator. He retired as a Colonel. I'm proud to be a military kid." Our pride continues with America's future soldiers, my friends. After high school, two of my friends will serve in the Army and Air Force.

Our family is leading an effort to recognize our Hometown Heroes. Our mission



is to both acknowledge and honor all our heroes. This includes our first responders. Their priceless service provides local protection and aid. Community members can sponsor a banner in honor of a military member or first responder. Our hope is that these banners will bring appreciation to those who served and continue to serve our great country.

HOMETOWN HEROES

James W. Townsend, Colonel, USA Ret.

"There are two categories of 'hard' from my experience in the military. First of all, when I had to leave Linda and later the kids for deployments. In fact, there was more than one time I was sent somewhere on short notice, and I couldn't tell her where I was going or what it was about because of the nature of the unit I was in and what was going on. And then, with Vietnam, I went there in 1972 and came back in 1973 after the cease fire. If I had had children, I might have gotten out of the Army. There was extreme turbulence at that time.

The second would be a death of a solider. I had soldiers die in training and in accidents. I had one soldier who was murdered. And the death of friends in combat. When I started off in Germany, we were working for a company commander, a captain, and there were four lieutenants. Of the four lieutenants, one had already been to Vietnam and gotten wounded. Of the other three, one was unscathed, the other one got killed in Vietnam the same year I was there and I got wounded in Vietnam. And then in another company, a very good friend was wounded the year I was there. He was shot out of a water tower by a tank and then captured and held in captivity. So, I remember all of those names. In Vietnam, my best friend in Vietnam... I got wounded on the 4th of July and he got killed on the 16th of August. So those moments were hard.

Now the physical demands. The lack of sleep. The, sometimes, hunger. I weigh 150 pounds now but after 4 meals and a night in the hospital, I weighed 114 pounds in Vietnam. I had to tape my ring or it would just fall right off. So those were just circumstances, and I wasn't bothered by it so much. I mean, if you're hungry, you're hungry. Get over it. If your tired, your tired. Work through it. When you're scared, it's just-function."

FishHawk Turkey Trot Gives Hope to Our Community

Family traditions are back...and with that comes The FishHawk Turkey Trot! Thanksgiving Day will once again begin with the largest road race in the Brandon area – The FishHawk Turkey Trot. Race officials are offering both in-person and virtual options so that everyone can participate when and where they want.

The FishHawk Turkey Trot is much more than a road race. The funds raised through the event go to meeting the needs of our community by alleviating local hunger. The Turkey Trot is the largest fundraiser for Seeds of Hope, Inc. Seeds of Hope provides weekly distributions of food through a food bank, a school backpack food program and a mobile pantry.

During the pandemic, Seeds of Hope saw numbers of people in need of food quadruple, going from 100 weekly boxes of food provided to families to over 400. In addition to providing food, Seeds of Hope also provides meaningful community service hours for students and many local students have received Bright Future scholarships based on their work through the charity.

Race director and Seeds of Hope President Leda Eaton is pleased to be offering the race once again, "People have missed it. My family missed it. It's the beginning of Thanksgiving...such a family fun event: people taking photos with our mascot turkeys, kids making crafts and dancing the "wobble" song, families running together; it just makes you smile. After this past year and a half, we all need that."



New this year, the race will be offering the first 100 across the finish line a goody bag of race themed prizes in lieu of age group medals. It's a much easier way to distribute prizes and requires less standing around by participants. Due to the size of the race, Eaton recommends socially distancing and wearing masks for those unvaccinated.

Seeds of Faith

Community Garden is a Faithful Place for **Growing Friendship and Food for Local Pantries**

Upcoming volunteer workdays: November 13 and December 11

Grab your garden gloves and make your way over to Bay Life Church's Seeds of Faith Community Garden, located in Brandon right behind the church's property. New and seasoned gardeners will enjoy working in the garden. There are opportunities for community service hours for students. Scouting organizations and other social groups can learn about gardening while they help garden. Volunteer workdays are the second Saturday of the month through June 2022.

The Seeds of Faith Community Garden is unique because it consists of two divided sections with individual grower beds and donation beds. The individual beds can be rented out to those interested in growing their own produce, while the donation beds are run by volunteers who then grow the produce to donate. It costs \$35 to rent a bed, which requires a six-hour volunteer commitment per year. It costs \$60 per year with no volunteer commitment.

Since the garden's establishment in 2010, more than 20,000 pounds of fresh produce has been donated to local food banks such as ECHO and Hope for Her.
