On behalf of the District's Board of Trustees have a safe and enjoyable holiday season.



Bloomingdale Residents Create First Ever Tampa Bay Taco Tour



Tampa Bay may not see snow this holiday season, but soon it'll be raining tacos. Taco Tours is filling stockings across the area with a one-of-a-kind experience: the 2022 Tampa Bay Taco Tour Book.

Bloomingdale residents Ryan and Katie Brown decided to start Taco Tours at the height of the COVID-19 pandemic with a goal to support local restaurants and to introduce people to taco restaurants in the area.

The pocket-sized tour book will guide passholders on their own schedule to over 20 locally owned taquerias in the Tampa Bay area where they'll receive free tacos. "When everything was shutting down, a lot of restaurant owners were worried about losing their businesses," said Brown. I sort of went on my own personal 'taco tour' around Tampa Bay and later had the idea to try and bring the experience to everyone."







Despite all the growth Hillsborough County has experienced there is still a wild outside, and you can explore it during the County's 2022 Hiking Spree. A record number of people participated last year, and now in its sixth year, the county is already on pace to exceed the number of past participants. Between now and March 31, 2022, hike at least eight of the trails listed on the website and you will receive a patch recognizing your efforts.

Chris Kiddy, Hillsborough County Parks & Recreation Community Engagement Manager said, "A lot of people don't realize how many amazing parks and trails we have in Hillsborough County. The Hiking Spree is a fun way for people to discover new places."

The different types of trails vary and include options for beginner and experienced hikers. Neighborhood Parks and Recreation Center trails are generally short paved trails with water and facilities. These parks are the perfect places for those new to hiking. Conservation Park Trails provide more of a nature experience than your typical Neighborhood Park trail. Though some are paved, most are primitive trails that take you through a variety of natural habitats ranging from upland pine flatwoods, to wetland swamps, to bottomland forests. Most of these parks have amenities such as running water, restrooms, playgrounds and manicured pathways. Nature Preserve Trails take the nature experience up several notches. Development is kept to a minimum to protect natural areas and wildlife. These trailheads have small, unpaved parking lots, a fence with a walk-through entrance and a small kiosk with trail information. These unpaved trails usually have rougher terrain and fewer markers. There are no restrooms or running water.

Does your dog want to be included? Kiddy said, "We recognized how much people love hiking with their pets, so last year we added an option for your pet to win a reward as well if they go on all the hikes with you. More than 2000 pets signed up and hundreds completed enough trails to get their very own Hiking Spree Bandana. We expect even more this year."






Bloomingdale High School Baseball Players Sign Letters of Intent
