Celebrate Queena's Birthday At Shopping Party Fundraiser

A Shopping Party will be held at Center Place on Sunday, April 24 from 2-6 p.m. to celebrate Queena's 32nd birthday and help with ongoing medical expenses. She survived the attack on her life at the Bloomingdale Regional Library 14 years ago.

It's been 14 years since Queena survived a violent attack made on her life at the Bloomingdale Regional Library leaving her with lifelong disabilities. Queena's Shopping Party, an event being held at Center Place on Sunday, April 24 from 2-6 p.m., will honor her 32nd birthday, and help raise funds for her ongoing medical needs as well as to Hope Heals The Brain, a 501c3 non-profit organization raising awareness and funds for families caring for individuals suffering traumatic brain injury in central Florida.

Queen's family is diligent about making sure she receives the proper care and support, and because of that, she is still making strides. To continue to make progress, her medical needs are great.

Her mom Vanna Nguyen said, "Queen's requires 100% assistance with every aspect of daily life, as well as numerous medical appointments and therapies. Her traumatic brain injury causes almost daily seizures. It's been extremely difficult for me, yet has simultaneously been the most rewarding experience."

The shopping party fundraiser will offset some of those expenses. Funds are needed to cover the cost of private home health-aids a few days a week, and to cover the cost of oxygen therapy at \$200/treatment as well as therapy in the water, which Medicaid does not cover as well as other therapies.

To attend, you must purchase a ticket. The cost is \$40 per person or \$75 for a couple. Kids under 5 are free. Entry to the party includes an Italian lunch and drinks and cake to help celebrate Queen's birthday. There will be music, and plenty of shopping. Attendees will have access to browse some favorite local stores.



Welcome to the Neighborhood: Mighty Heroes Nutrition Childhood Cancer Nonprofit Store Offers Nutritious Drinks

From the age of 6, Tina Downing knew that she wanted to make an impact on the lives of children. In 2017 she started a childhood cancer nonprofit called Small But Mighty Heroes (SBMH). She recently opened a shop at 3240 Lithia Pinecrest Rd., Ste. 103. Mighty Heroes Nutrition offers nutrition shakes, tea, lemonade and coffee. A ribbon cutting was held on March 5 with the Valrico Chamber of Commerce to welcome the new store to the neighborhood.

The organization focuses on children impacted by childhood cancer and their families. "We offer tailored support for each of these children and their families. We truly focus on what is impactful to them as we remain constant and relevant no matter where they are in their journey. As we say here at SBMH, it takes a village and no child fights alone," Downing added.

Downing's journey began when she was introduced to boy named Blake who had Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia and passed away at age two. "My heart was invested in him and I took his passing very hard," she said.

Downing felt there had to be so much more for these incredible little superheroes. With the opening of the store, she hopes to spread awareness of childhood cancer and use it to bring in much needed funding for children battling cancer.

She said, "Our goal is to bring the community together to help us fight for a cause that is much greater than ourselves and to spread awareness of childhood cancer one drink at a time."

University of Tampa Takes a Bloomingdale Field Trip

On February 18, the University of Tampa's Field Ornithology class took a field trip to Bloomingdale. The class is designed to use encounters with wild birds in nature to teach upper-level science majors (many of which are preparing for careers as professional biologists) about the biology of birds. Every week they embark on a 4-hour trip to a park or nature preserve in the Tampa Bay area.

Professor Mark McRae said, "By teaching Ornithology 'in the field' my students not only learn the basic biology, they also acquire the skills to identify different species of birds, by sight and sound, which will serve them well in their future careers."

McRae brought the class to Sandy Reed's yard in Bloomingdale East because of her reputation in the local birdwatching and bird conservation community. Sandy is the Chairman of the Tampa Audubon Society Bird Protection Committee. McRae explained that Bullock's Orioles and Western Tanagers are normally found in the western United States. Sandy has one of each species that regularly visits her backyard.

"By being able to visit Sandy's yard, I could teach my students about vagrancy in birds, as well as the role that backyard bird feeders can play in modern bird conservation," explained McRae. "My students were definitely inspired by her and have clearly indicated that our visit to her yard was one of the highlights of our semester."

Bloomingdale Resident Publishes Book Honoring Marines

Honor in the Marines has a storied history. In fact, the beginning lines of the Marines' Hymn, which originates from the 19th century, are: "And to keep our honor clean; We are proud to claim the title; Of United States Marine."

Bloomingdale resident LT COL (Ret) Sidney Atwater, US Marine Corps has published a book for and about marines. In the book, he shares the stories of marines and honors them using their own words.


Atwater's collection of quotes started as a way to motivate and inspire the people he worked with in the Marines. The book was 35 years in the making.

"I always thought it was rather cool to find a quote about marines. I would just write it down and say who said it. For many, many years- 25 years- this was nothing more than what I called an oorah opportunity. It was just my way of sharing Marine history. I shared it with people I worked with. It was just motivational," said Atwater.

So many enjoyed his quote collection that colleagues regularly asked for copies to share and use to inspire others.

Atwater retired in 1998. At that point, he wondered if he had enough material for a book. His collection and research grew as he worked on it from time to time over the years. When the Covid pandemic happened, he decided to dedicate time to his book.

By, For, and About Marines: A book of notable quotes of the U.S. Marine Corps was published in July 2021. It is available at Amazon, Barnes and Noble and Xlibris.



Atwater's book *By, For, and About Marines: A book of notable quotes of the U.S. Marine Corps* contains more than 850 quotes and related historical information. According to Atwater, history is alive for marines; history holds the values of honor, courage and commitment together for marines.

"We go out of our way to imbue the new recruits, both enlisted and officers, with the knowledge that they are part of a long tradition. Now it is your turn so don't let the guys who came before us down. We imbue them with that spirit of honor through the teaching of history," Atwater said.

Burns Girls Basketball Team Honored by Tampa Mayor






