## Manatee Viewing Center Offers First-Hand Look at Florida's Most Gentle Creatures

Get a first-hand look at Manatees this winter at TECO's Big Bend Power Station in Apollo Beach. Learn about these magnificent gentle creatures and what it takes for their survival.

Manatees, which are mammals, need warmer water. In colder months when gulf and bay temperatures drop below 68 degrees, they migrate to warmer areas. The discharge canal at the TECO site is a state and federally designated manatee sanctuary where the water is a constant 72 degrees.

"We're proud to be the showcase for Tampa Electric's commitment to environmental stewardship," said Stan Kroh, Manager of Land and Stewardship Programs for Tampa Electric. "The Manatee Viewing Center proves that you can have fun while learning about the natural treasures of Florida."

Although the manatees are the main attraction, there is so much more to see and do.

Visitors can enjoy the stingrays touch-tank. You can touch them gently as they glide past you. Wander along boardwalks overlooking the warm-water area where manatees gather while also watching for birds and larger fish that may be visible from the walkway.

Wear comfortable shoes as you can also hike a coastal habitat trail which is close to a mile in length and winds through saltern, coastal high marsh and coastal strand habitats. The setting is very natural and showcases a variety of plant and animal life. Along the trail is an observation tower with a 50 ft. vantage point. Relax or bring a picnic lunch to enjoy at one of the tables at the base of the tower or get a bite to eat at the Southshore Café.

Manatees often swim in water less than six feet deep where underwater vegetation is most abundant. Sadly, this makes them susceptible to boat strikes. Many have recently suffered from starvation as their food source diminishes. More than 735 deaths have already been reported this year.

The Manatee Viewing Center draws about 400,000 visitors annually. It is located at 6990 Dickman Rd. in Apollo Beach and is open 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily (except Christmas and Easter) through April 15, 2023. Trails close at 4 p.m. Admission and parking are free. No pets are allowed except trained service dogs.

#### Welcome to the Neighborhood New Business *Bin*efitng the Bloomingdale Community

Cleaning and sterilizing trash bins is a dirty job that no one wants to do, well no one except a Bloomingdale local that is! Wes Brown, a resident of the Bloomingdale community for over 11 years, just launched his new business, Bin Steamers. The company specializes in providing trash bin and dumpster cleaning services that can be done as a regular or one time service.

Wes was an ER medic for 12 years, so he knows the importance of limiting the spread of germs, especially during this time of the year, when the flu and other viruses are so prevalent in our community. Wes explained, "Most people just don't realize the amount of bacteria that lives and thrives on trash bins. Being in the medical field, I started having my own trash bins cleaned at the start of the pandemic, and I noticed how much better my garage smelled and how nice it was to throw a bag in and not be nauseated by the smell of the lid shutting. But then the man that was servicing our bins moved and when I tried to find another company, I realized there was a need for this service in our area, and I decided it was a need I could fill."

So, whether your trash bin is constantly full of diapers, or perhaps the remnants of your annual crab boil, Bin Steamers provides curbside bin cleaning that cleans both the outside and the inside of the bin. The process involves the use of a \$6200 piece of equipment that picks the trash bin up and places it at an angled downward position while a rotating head propels 230° water that sterilizes, disinfects, and deodorizes the bin in an eco-friendly manner using less water than if you were to clean the bin by hand. All services are performed directly after trash pickup and then Bin Steamers rolls the freshly cleaned bins back up to the garage. Currently Bin Steamers provides three service packages:

A one-time cleaning at \$39.95 and \$10 for each additional bin A quarterly rate of \$29.95 and \$10 for each additional bin A monthly rate of \$19.95 and \$5 for each additional bin

This service can also be purchased as a gift for others for the holidays, if you are trying to find something practical for the person who already has it all!


#### It's beginning to look a lot like Christmas... in Bloomingdale


#### **Festival of Lights and Santa's Village Open at Hillsborough County Fairgrounds**

Soccer player Aubrey Cripe signed to play at Newberry College.


