

# Bloomingdale Special District Office Moves to New Home

The Bloomingdale Special District (BSD) has relocated from its former Bell Shoals Road location to Erindale Road near the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office substation. The new office opens today, July 5. Visitors are welcome Monday to Thursday from 8 a.m. - noon.

According to Tom Leech, President of the Bloomingdale Special District, "The new location on Erindale Road puts us inside Bloomingdale in a quieter location that also provides easier access for community residents. The space is slightly larger, but the location was the driver, not the office size." He also cited increased costs, security and safety concerns around the former property as reasons for the move.

Bloomingdale has become a thriving community since development began in the 1980s. No other community provides such a welcome retreat from the busy highways in so dramatic a way as Bloomingdale, and this is what the BSD strives to maintain.

Bloomingdale is a desirable place to live. Leech, who has been on the board for 8 1/2 years, says that the BSD protects the community's common areas and keeps the area beautiful. It does this through proactive management of community infrastructure while being good stewards of constituent tax dollars.

Leech said, "It is sad that so many residents do not realize that we are an arm of Hillsborough County and that a portion of their property taxes goes directly into the community via the BSD. We are not an HOA and have no authority over the HOAs or the subdivisions. We manage the common areas from the walls to the street, excluding the sidewalks."

The budget for fiscal year 2023 is approximately \$1.1M. A special tax of \$170 is levied on each home in our community for the maintenance of common areas, community entrances, and landscaping. The tax is collected with the Hillsborough County Tax Bill.

Board meetings are held at 6:30 p.m. on the second Monday of each month. All meetings are open to the public.

ZooTampa's origins began in the 1930s and through the years, it has been known by many names, but most of us remember it as Lowry Park Zoo. In 2018, it was rebranded as ZooTampa and I recently returned with my grandchildren and we absolutely loved it!

ZooTampa is a great place to see animals from other parts of the world, such as the golden lion tamarin, the African painted dog, and the Angolan colobus monkey. More important is that your visit, especially for children, can be used as a teaching tool as to the importance of protecting each animal's habitat.

"I am tremendously proud of ZooTampa's involvement in efforts protecting wildlife locally and globally," said Dr. Cynthia Stringfield, Senior VP of Animal Health, Conservation & Education.

Plan to arrive early to visit a popular attraction, Expedition Wild Africa Safari. Here you travel aboard custom-built open-air vehicles to see up-close, the animals that call the Habari Preserve home such as giraffes, zebras, and elephants.

Wallaroo Station is popular among children. Along with wallabies and koalas, kids can enjoy play areas and cool off in splash pads or enjoy a few rides such as the Tasmanian Tiger Coaster and the Overland Express Train. Near the entrance is the Jungle Carousel and Roaring Springs, a water ride perfect for cooling off.

Throughout the day, zoo personnel offer chats and demonstrations where you can connect personally with some of the zoo residents including the Gharial crocodile, African penguins, Giraffes, Rhinos and more. Visit http://zootampa.org/visit/my-zoo-day/#wildlife-connections for times and locations.

Conservation is a top priority for ZooTampa. Over the last 20 years, teams have rescued and rehabilitated more than 500 injured, sick, and orphaned manatees. More than 280 of them have been reintroduced into Florida waters. Florida panthers are rehabbed too and the zoo is home to three that are unable to survive on their own in the wild.

"With our conservation work in our backyard with Florida manatees and panthers and globally with our partners, the zoo is uniquely positioned to help protect wildlife through the expertise of staff, the contributions made to science, and the special moments guests experience that also forge empathy and resolve in taking action to help protect the future of wildlife. The collective impact is truly inspiring," added Stringfield.

ZooTampa has been recently named USA Today's #6 in the nation for the best zoo. It was also rated #4 for best zoo exhibit for its manatee critical care center. If you have Disney+, check out the four seasons of National Geographic's "Secrets of the Zoo: Tampa" to get additional insight behind the scenes.



## WELCOME TO THE NEIGHBORHOOD

Deborah and William Steele have lived in this community since 2006 and recently saw a growing need for children to have more exposure to technology. With more than 50 years of IT experience between the two of them, along with



extensive backgrounds in cybersecurity, engineering, and military service, they were the perfect couple to fill that need and open Skill Samurai Coding and STEM Academy.

Deborah explained "Technology is becoming as important as reading and writing in a child's education."

Skill Samurai offers children ages 5 - 18 in-person STEM experiences in coding, robotics, game development, 3D printing and more. Deborah said that while most students can find STEM and IT based tutorials online, their "brick and mortar facility allows kids, who share the same interests, the opportunity to bond over shared passions."

In addition to making friends and learning new STEM based standards, she added, "Skill Samurai can also help students approach thinking as logical building blocks that can become a foundation that carries over into other areas of interest and study."
