PRESIDENT'S LETTER

Dear Friends & Neighbors:

Bloomingdale Homeowners Association. What is it besides a name? Why was it created, and for what purpose? Many times after an organization of any kind is formed, especially a new one such as ours, it takes a few years for that organization and the people it represents to determine the direction they want their group to follow. Or sometimes wonder why it ever was formed in the first place.

Well our by-laws were written 2 years ago with the following purposes:

"To organize and operate a homeowners association exclusively for community improvements and other non-profitable purposes..... The purposes for which the organization shall function shall include:

- 1) The promotion of a spirit of neighborly relations and cooperation among property owners and residents of the community.
- 2) The achievement of cooperation in obtaining improved utilities, governmental services, and other beneficial improvements for the community.
- 3) The maintenance of a high standard of morality in the community and vigorous opposition to any encroachment or conduct of whatever kind and description which may tend to lower the moral standard of the community.
- 4) The promotion of physical improvement of the community for the common good of its property owners and residents and opposition to any act whatever kind which may tend to depreciate the property values in the community.

Think about it. Are we doing what we were formed to do? Are we fulfilling the purposes for which we were organized? Or, are our purposes and goals still not clearly formed as the result of the relative youth of our community? What do you think? Let us know what you feel the Association should be doing. Your suggestions are welcomed.

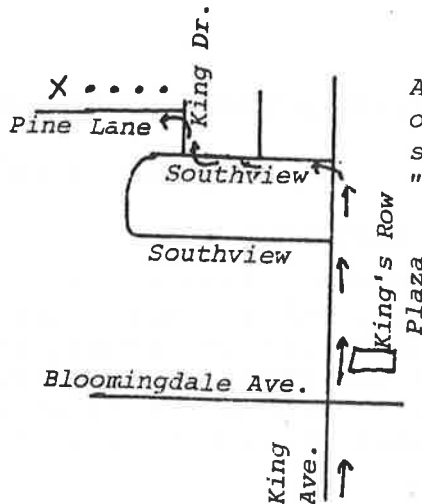
