A call to animal control was made & we found out they do not test wild animals for rabies unless they have bitten, scratched or licked a human or pet. This is due to the fact the test costs \$75. They also said that not all wild animals with rabies are aggressive (this one wasn't).

Be sure to warn your families not to approach a raccoon, squirrel, etc. as there is always the chance of rabies.

Also, if you have a pet, please be sure it has had its shots. There are wild animals here and it's always better to be safe than sorry.


