GLODMINGDALE FAFE WEST, FFiIVATE OR COUNTY ???


Durina the month of Octaber 25 was discovered accidentally that Criterion had made arrangements with The Hillsborough Gounty Fark: Department to dedicate Fark West as a county park, neqating it"s use as a private park for $\dot{\text { flomonnadale }}$ residents. After spearing with dim Selvey, County Commisioner and Ed Fiadice, Director af the Fiarles Department to contirm this dedi cation, Susan Meitz, Criterion Corporation was 1 nvited to speals at the Dctober EHA meeting where she did Eoncur that Criterion (as representatives of the partes owners, MGIC) was negotiating with the county reaarding Fiark West to avoid having to pay impact fees. That evening Fuss Thompson and a group of concerned citizens formed a Fiark Committee with fuss as Chairman. During the last of October several things were accomplished: 1) Attarney Fichard Wheeler met with Criterion. 2) The Fark Committee had a meetina. (s) Contact was made with Ed Fadice reqarding our options.

It wes found that should the residents decide that Fiark West was to remain orivate it had to be deeqed either to the BHA tempararily or the STD permanently. Also Criterion was aemandina some sort of positive assurances that the paris would be maintained-- such as the passaqe of the STD or a \$10, 000 escrow account, or both.

During November an all resident meetina was set up at Hrandon Hiah School. Griy 67 people went to listen as the praxs and $\operatorname{con}^{3} s$ ot the Eounty park were debated and Ed Fiacice made a presentation as to what the countr could da.

What +ollows are the highilahts of three important areas: 1) what Ed Fiadice and the Fark Department will doga) the result of an investigation team: and उ) the neqative aspects of a county parti: - .

Mr. Fiadice hag stated they would like to build a Community Euildina which would be manned by full time park department personal. They would have games. activities: crafts and educational classes for all levels. There would be much needed impravement of the playground equipment with the additign af a Tat Lot. Lights would be added ta the tennis courts, possible expansion of the raquetbal 1 courts. general clean-up of the area and requilar maintenance to the entire pariz areas and added口arking spaces. They would alsa clean up but not remove the conservation area benind Fiark West, possible addina a nature walkway throuah it. See the site plan man in this Gazette. page 8

Un Thursday, November 14, the Assistant County Attorney, Amelia Brown, informed us of two items: first the STD Boara of Trustees would reauire the submission of seven resumes not tive as we were originally told, and second, that the Decemper 4 Fublic Hearina could not tate place as we had hooed until December 18. Theretore, all reslimes submitted before the STD Committee were brauaht to the biHA meetina the evening before the first Commission hearing.

Then, on Wednesday November 20. Attornev Fichard Wheeler and Committee Chairwoman Susan Deluca appeared before the Bosrd of County Commissiqners. At that time they presented verified betition signatures, the completed ordinance, and the resumes of seven trustees plus alternates. After less than ane minute of debaten Commissioner Jim Selvey moved that the Special Tasina District for Blominadale be plared on the agenda for a Fublic Hearina on December 1g. This motion was seconded by several other Commissioners and unanimously approved by all seven.

The seven STD Trustees that were approved at the November 1 ? qeneral membership meeting of the BHA are: Thomas M. Calcaterras CFA: J. Christopher Deem, Attorneve Glenda M. Hewitt: Fobert Knott: Christopher Lee Fheils, F.A.C. Fiussell D. Thompson; Fred Uphott Jras and alternates Josent D. Deluca, Jr., CFP, and M. Gearae Besa.

On December 18 at the County Court House on Fierce Street, the Fublic Hearina will be held before the Countr Commissioners ta hear pro and con araliments reqardina the establishment of our Saecial Taxina District. AS this is a Fublic Hearing, all residents of Bloominadale are welcome to attend and express their opinions reqarding the formation ot the STD to maintain the common areas.

After the Fublic Hearing and approval of the STD, Bloominqdale resident Jeff west will hand carry our STD ordinance to the Secretary of

State 10 Tallanasseo for sianature before December $31,19 B 5 . \quad$ Once tinis is accomplished the STD becomes law and the seven trbsters become oナ+1:1al.
$A s$ the residents of Bloominadele did sign petiさions showing aminimum of 7 O\% approval ot the STD, it 15 hoped that the Fublac Hearing and the otticial siqnatures are sometiona that can be accomplished guicicly and to the advantage of Bloominadale.

If you are planning to give or receive a pet for Christmas. why not plan of bringing it home a few days after Christmas? Christmas morning is such a hectic time, not exactly a calm, quiet time to introduce a new puppy ar kitten into your home.
Christmas is also a time of special dancers to your pets. CasEs attracted to the shinny objects, may 1 ingest "icicles" , often requiring emergency surgery to remove the obstruction. Last year, we had a dog that had eaten $Z$ ornaments from the tree. Dangling wires are also a danger to pets from chew ina. Try to watch your pets more carefully during the holidays: to avoid possible hazard. During the holidays keep your aet on its regular diet. It Is easy to give in to their beqaina and ave them treats from the table, but that practice may give your pet gastroenteritis, and may even require an emergency visit ta the vet. Please note that chocolate may cause severe problems in dogs. if eaten. and in large amounts may even cause seizurina in dogs. And beware of thieves: last year we saw a black Lab on emergency, whoa had eaten an entire 12 lb. turkey that he had stolen ot t a counter.

WILL MOBILE WATLH SLFVVVE？ by Dave Evetan
 our population has steadily inereased．we presently have 82 Mobile watch valunteers wha rearesent a community of 3,000 adult residents． Obviously：the majority of our residents must feel that the Mobile Watch 15 unnecessary－－then 1 ask yous who da I receive 20 to 30 calls a month requesting our assistance？

In December，we have been forced to reduce our coverage to tour nights a weer－－we iust don＇t have the people！Simply stated we are Eontemplating dis口andina the Mobile Watch in January unless December becomes a record month for new volunteers．Betore you shrua lis off，I ask each of you to gansider the followina：

1）Our Nei ahborhood watch Frouram $i s$ a facade and oorders on the realm of nonexistant． $1+$ vou don＇t belleve me，activate your teleohone roster and see what happens！Dur Mobile Watch is the only community crime prevention effort that le still functional．

2）A few years ano，the Motile Waten falded due to lact：of support． The crime rate increased so sharply that a group of dedicated residents reorganised the program Cunfortunately，it took a rash of buirglaries to convince residents that their support and the Mobile Watch were indeed needed）．We now enioy one of the lowest crime rates in Hilistorounh County and personally I＂m convinced out Mobile watch is an eftective deterrent to rising crime rates．Eecause af the arowth af our community：it would be virtually impossible to start all gver aqヨin once we＇ve aci：e minder－othe iarger the mumbers，the harder to oraanize！

3）E＋fectiveness： 1 could write ₹ book on the things we＇ve done for the community in just the past vear． Surely，those wham we ve helped are thent＋ul：how about supportina us．now that we need vour helo？what about you wives who teel more secure just Knowing the Movile Wateh is a phone call away when vour husbands are out of town an business－－women are welcome to volunteer as are husband／wife teams！

4）The Sherıt＋3 5 department has been superb in responding to Mobile Watch reports of 1 nisidents，suspected crimes，and even auto aceldents． While i＇m certain they will provide the same proficient response ta a resident！s request，it the Mobile Waten fails，who will be on the seene until the sherift＇s patrol arrives？ Just recently，we were ヨble to have a physician（one of our members）at an accident scene before the police or ambulance arrived！

This is a last ditoh effort to drum up support for the Mobile watch．The community is fortunate to have a few dedicated organizers who are tryina to keer the Mobile Watch alive：we do not get paid for our nights and Weekends of loyal＂volunteer＂ service，for the verbal attacks from people we are trving to helo，for the names we＇re called when responaing to a disturbanice in the Fark for the phone calls in the middle of the night for the last minute frustration ot iugaling shitts due to no－shows for the disapoointment we feel inside when residents califor help and we can ${ }^{3}$ t respond because we den＇t have enouah volunteers，tor the aqony of maliina and distributina a workable monthly schecule when we have more peaple argaping out than joinina．for the police tinoctina Et bur doors at 2a．m．for more details on an lncident that happened earlier in the evenina，for havina to decline invitations to dinner because we have Gase station 4 ar 5 times a month， for havina to bea resicents for money 50 we Ean fix our radios，and most important．tor havina ta cope with the notion that the rest of the
