#### EDITORIAL

Through a major effort of a few people in the East a strong opposition has been raised to the convenience store by Park East, including a financial obligation. Maybe next month someone will be needed to fight a store or poolhall in the West or Estates, who will come forward, I doubt many of the 300++ who oppose the current issue. The real frustation is in this opposition group going independent of their, our, Association. device to voice our concerns for all, not just one area, a greater voice. Few of the opposers of this store are BHA members. The BHA is a Democratic group, if the membership wants to change a Director or position, they need only speak (vote). Even if the majority doesn't oppose an issue, that doesn't mean they can't lend support to a small special interest group. Why isn't this opposition group spendinga few dollars to join the in-place organization and taking over direction with their votes, instead of waiting for a few to decide the issue, and then say the BHA opposes them?? Maybe we need 12 different homeowner groups, one for each small section of Bloomingdale, either that or hope there will always be a few concerned persons with enough time and energy to organize and conduct these splinter groups. And, be prepared to spend BIG bucks, especially against the bigger buck developers who may come our way. (The developer can change the zoning Park East and Golf Course deletions -- The BHA was there for us on those). Important issues will come again. It is past time we decided if we want an Assoc-A few people can't do it, ask the old directors who have disappeared. We need the people we try to represent to give the group direction and support, to take control of your own investment in this community. I have the utmost respect and admoration for the leaders of this opposition group, they have the "grit" to stand up and say "this is my neighborhood, my developement, we don't want..... this is where I stand". I only wish they had put their effort through the BHA, in not doing so they may have damaged things for the rest of us, because these concerned community advocates aren't going to be here to do OUR work for us forever. If you feel a developement wide association is beneficial, or could be, join, support, if an issue of concern to you comes up, speak out, if it is of strong concern -- get active. If you want a neighbor on the Board, vote him/her to the job. If not then get your street organized, the issues aren't going to go away, or you can close your curtains and pretend you live in the country, all by yourself, until someone puts a convenience store across from your house, or your Park is in shambles and your property values slide.


After reading the article which appeared in the February 9th, edition of the Hillsbourough East, I feel I have to clarify any confusion that the article may have caused.

Toxoplasmosis by Dr. Wissman, D.V. A.

Pregnant women should be aware of a disease called Toxoplasmosis. When acquired during pregnancy, it can cause birth defects, spontaneous abortions or stillbirth.

Toxoplasmosis is relatively common and is caused by a single-celled parasite, toxoplasma gondii. Most people who get toxo have few symptoms or none at all. Others may have swollen glands, fatigue, malaise, muscle pain, low fever, rash, headache, or sore throat.

The common household cat is the only animal known to shed toxo parasites in its feces. If your cat is infected you could get toxo from its feces in the litter box or garden.

Toxo can be avoided. Keep your cat free of infection by feeding it only commercial cat food. Keep it indoors so that it cannot hunt or eat mice or birds.


Change the cat litter daily. If possible someone other

than the expectant mother should do this.

Another way of getting Toxo is by eating raw or undercooked meat. Cook all meat and poultry thoroughly. or cook homegrown vegetables that may have come in contact with cat feces in the garden. Wash your hands after touching raw meat, after changing the cat litter, or working in gardens that cats have access to.













For those of you who haven't figured it out there is a proposed convenience store being opposed by some of the homeowners. The store is slated to be built across from park east. The builder says it will be a low profile-high class store which will blend in and be an asset to Bloomingdale. The opposition group feels we don't need that type of store within the confines of the development. And they feel that any store that sells peer and wine across from our park. Both groups met the Zoning Master last week. The Zoning Master has to make it's recommendations to the County Commission in 15 days. The Commission will then consider the matter in the agenda on Mar 19. If the Zoning Master recommends favorable action (approval of the beer sales zoning) ((thats their term, not mine)) then the opposition group will petition the County Commission to have their lawyer speak at the meeting on the 19th, and state the case against the store directly. 


