School District Holds Meetings with Community on Formulating Boundaries for New Riverview Schools

The Bloomingdale Homeowners Association, Inc. and the ad hoc Bloomingdale Area Citizens for Neighborhood Schools previously announced that on Friday, December 5, Dr. Earl Lennard, Superintendent of Schools agreed to remove the District's school boundary proposal for the new Riverview and Rogers Middle Schools in Riverview from the December 9 School Board Meeting. This boundary proposal would have divided the Bloomingdale Community at Bell Shoals Road with all students living west of Bell Shoals traveling to Riverview for middle and high school.

The District has agreed to work closely with representatives of the community to attempt to draw boundaries which will best meet the needs of the community and our children's education. The first two meetings were scheduled for Monday, December 15 and Wednesday December 17, 1997. Additional meetings will be scheduled as required. The School District hopes to have the School Board approve new school boundaries by the end of January.

Ted Grable, a Director of the Bloomingdale Homeowners Association, Inc. said "The BHA and Bloomingdale Area Citizens for Neighborhood Schools believe that this agreement to work with the communities is a new and very innovative commitment on the part of the School District. It wishes to recognize School Superintendent Earl Lennard's leadership and personal commitment in demonstrating the District's effort to work more closely with local communities in formulating school boundaries and to increase consideration of neighborhood and community needs in that process."

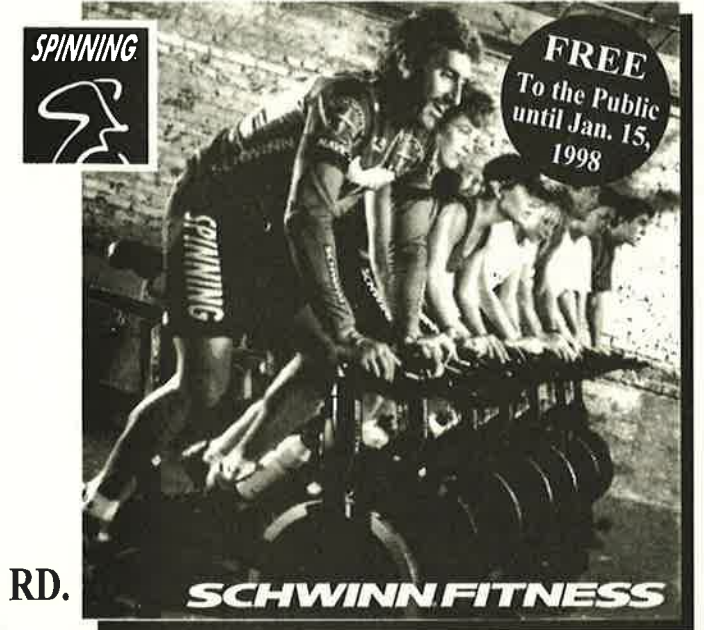

I am writing as a concerned resident of Bloomingdale West. My reason for this concern is the bus stop at the corner of Fieldstone & Canoga Park. Sometime between 4:00 P.M. and 4:20 P.M. children from Burns Middle school are let off at the bus stop. I pass this area at least three times a week on my way home from work. I have yet to pass it without some type of trouble being dealt with by either myself or some other resident passing by.

Mostly it is fighting and/or someone trying to pull down street signs (as noted by

the Fieldstone Street sign in present leaning position). This particular bus stop has a large number of children and I have noticed over the past three months that this problem with the kids surrounding the fight or participating in "holding" others in a position to be struck by others is progressively leading to more violence.

I am urging any and all of the parents that have children that use this bus stop in the morning/afternoon to begin supervising this bus stop until the kids have dispersed. Please participate in your children's safety.

Bay Area Water Supply

Water shortage...the need for conservation... Water Wars...water "stealing"...charges of over pumping... environmental damage. Water is a hot issue in Tampa Bay...but what is really going on in the water arena? What is the truth?

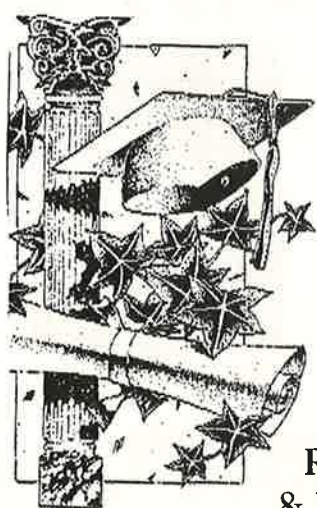
Florida's growth has challenged our water system to the max. If we don't do something now, we are at risk of running short of water. And conservation alone is not the answer.

But running out of water is not within the frame of reference of most citizens: after all they turn their taps on and water flows, so how could we be short? The truth is demand is high and getting higher. We need new water supplies to not only meet need, but to protect the environment.

After years of study and planning, the West Coast Regional Water Supply Authority has recommended that the Tampa Bay region adopt a **regional water system**, one they call The Master Water Plan.

The plan would provide for two-way flow in the Tri-County area: Hillsborough, Pinellas and Pasco. Water supplies could be efficiently managed so that all areas received the water needed. The plan includes a number of projects in Hillsborough County that would provide new sources of water.

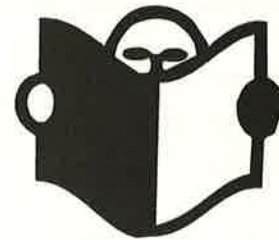

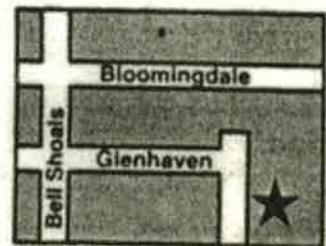
