School District Holds Meetings with Community on Formulating Boundaries for New Riverview Schools

The Bloomingdale Homeowners Association, Inc. and the ad hoc Bloomingdale Area Citizens for Neighborhood Schools previously announced that on Friday, December 5, Dr. Earl Lennard, Superintendent of Schools agreed to remove the District's school boundary proposal for the new Riverview and Rogers Middle Schools in Riverview from the December 9 School Board Meeting. This boundary proposal would have divided the Bloomingdale Community at Bell Shoals Road with all students living west of Bell Shoals traveling to Riverview for middle and high school.

The District has agreed to work closely with representatives of the community to attempt to draw boundaries which will best meet the needs of the community and our children's education. The first two meetings were scheduled for Monday, December 15 and Wednesday December 17, 1997. Additional meetings will be scheduled as required. The School District hopes to have the School Board approve new school boundaries by the end of January.

Ted Grable, a Director of the Bloomingdale Homeowners Association, Inc. said "The BHA and Bloomingdale Area Citizens for Neighborhood Schools believe that this agreement to work with the communities is a new and very innovative commitment on the part of the School District. It wishes to recognize School Superintendent Earl Lennard's leadership and personal commitment in demonstrating the District's effort to work more closely with local communities in formulating school boundaries and to increase consideration of neighborhood and community needs in that process."
