As you are aware there is considerable controversy over the potential loss of our recreational area in Blooming-dale East. You may not be aware that the recreation area/park in Bloomingdale West may also be lost to us by becoming a part of a new YMCA to be built within the 17 acres of that park site. There is also planning underway which could result in relocating & enlarging the little league complex presently located at the intersection of Bloomingdale & Lithia-Pinecrest roads. This enlarged complex (which is operated & administrated by another civic association) could wind-up somewhere within Bloomingdale East.

There was recently held a special meeting with representatives from B.H.A. & Criterion Corp. in attendance. These points & many others were discussed at great length. It is not possible in these few short sentences to cover the details of the meeting.
