#### PRESIDENT'S LETTER

With the new year we have several issues of importance to our community in a very active status. The construction of our Golf Course and associated Country Club is at full speed. The initial ground clearing has begun for a community shopping center at Bell Shoals and Bloomingdale.

The Special Taxing District Bill has been submitted to the County Commission with a work shop scheduled for the latter part of this month. If you feel confused or have some question(s) regarding the S.T.D., you will be pleased to know the S.T.D. committee, in conjunction with your B.H.A. Board of Directors, are preparing a "FACT PACKAGE" addressing areas of question as expressed by homeowners over the past several weeks. This "FACT PACKAGE" will be available at our next General Membership Meeting on Tuesday, January 18, 1983.

We are still looking for an adequate location within Bloomingdale West/Estates to hold a General Membership Meeting. The existing Suarez, Hallmark, and Pulte Sales offices in the West section are not adequate for the number of people we have in attendance.

There still seems to be a little confusion surrounding the apparent connections between the Bloomingdale Community Neighborhood Watch program and the B.H.A. They are two completely independent and separate organizations with mutually exclusive Boards. By that I mean that no individual can serve as a Board Member for both organizations at the same time. The only connections between the two organizations are:

- ... they both draw from the community residents for their volunteer man-power.
- ... the B.H.A. has donated money to the Neighborhood Watch Program for purchase/repair of equipment.

#### NOTICE TO ALL HOMEOWNER'S ASSOCIATION MEMBERS

As required in the Constitution of the Bloomingdale Homeowner's Association, any change to the Constitution & By-Laws must be submitted at a regular membership meeting. All members shall be notified of the proposed changes & such a motion shall be open at the next regular meeting of the Association. A two-thirds majority of those present shall be necessary to effect such alterations or amendments.

The change to the By-Laws and amendment to the Constitution involve the clarification of the role of the Vice President in the organization of the association.

Be it proposed that Article VI, Section 2, of the Constitution be amended to read: .... The Vice President shall act as Chairman of the Board and conduct all Board Meetings.

Be it proposed that Section 1 of the By-Laws be changed to read:
...The Board of Directors should meet at least once a month. The Vice
President shall preside over all meetings of the Board, and in his
absence, the President.

These proposals will be placed before the General Membership at the December meeting for consideration and if accepted, will be voted upon at the January meeting.


We would, also, like to take this opportunity to invite you to run -registration forms can be picked up at the Criterion Sales Office on


