## Original Graphic Processes

- LITHOGRAPH The artist draws directly on a flat stone or metal plate with crayons or pens.

  The stone is dampened with water and then rolled with ink. The ink adheres to the greasy crayon marks but not to the dampened areas. The image is then printed by pressing paper against the stone, which is referred to as "pulling the print."
- ETCHING The image is created by the artist on a metal plate by means of engraving tools or acid. This produces the sunken line which will receive the ink. In printing, the ink settles in the sunken areas and the plate is wiped clean. The plate, in contact with damp paper, is passed through a roller press, and the paper is forced into the sunken areas to receive the ink.
- COLLOGRAPH The printing surface on the plate is built up by applying various materials and/ or plants. This produces a textured effect on the paper when printed.
- SERIGRAPH A tightly stretched screen, usually of silk, is prepared by the artist. Areas not to be printed are blocked out by filling up the mesh of the screen with a varnish-like substance, leaving a stencil-type effect. Paper is placed under the screen and ink forced through the still open mesh onto the paper. A separate stencil is used for each color. This is also referred to frequently as a "silk screen print."

#### LETTER TO THE EDITOR

Dear Homeowners:

We were successful in surveying 164 homes during the weekend of Jan. 15 - 16, receiving 191 signatures against a STD now. Only 8% of the homes visited decided not to sign our petition. I had originally believed that we would have met more refusals to sign since the BHA petition had a 73% majority in favor of the STD. We were all pleasantly surprised with the results we received.

I was naive enough to believe that the BHA Board of Directors (being a FACT finding organization) & the STD Committee (being the sponsors of the petition to our state legislators) would begin to see that we were traveling too fast with the STD & that the issue could face defeat at the polls if it should go that far. At the public hearing before local representatives to the state legislature on Jan. 22. both the proponent & opposition opinions were expressed. Now the BHA has been issued a directive to once & for all determine the majority attitude towards the STD. This decision has to be ready to be delivered to the legislators at a workshop on February 11, 1983. Our local representative & senator are very interested in what you have to say about this issue. 
