RECREATION COMMITTEE REPORT

The recreation committee was re-activated at the May Board of Directors meeting and so far consists of the people listed above. Anyone with suggestions or ideas for activities is invited to contact any of the people on the committee or any Board member.

During the month of June we initiated a new program for some of our kids. You may remember the May Gazette Ad for someone to sweep Park East tennis courts. Within 24 hours I had 22 kids willing, but only one job. Daryl Turney was awarded the job on the basis of a random drawing. Because of the large response, we began a series of discussions with Criterion aimed at putting more kids (10 total) to work within the development (East, West & Estates) sweeping tennis courts, handball courts, and cleaning up the parks, entrances and other areas. We hope to have the kids working soon. All the jobs will pay \$10.00 per month and range from twice a week to twice a month duties. The remaining 9 kids will be chosen from the initial list of 22 who called me for the tennis court sweeping job. If you wish to add your name to the list and are under 16, call me at 689-8090.

Recently, a group of young people approached B.H.A. for a donation to sponsor a youth soccer team. For various reasons, the group was turned down at a General Membership meeting. The Board of Directors at the June Board Meeting expanded the recreation committee's responsibility to include a review of all requests for donation/sponsorship for sports oriented organizations. The purpose of this review is to provide the General Membership with specific facts prior to voting on the issue, to avoid having worthwhile and beneficial organizations turned down for lack of information.
