

Bloomingdale, Burns reach out to Haiti

The small country of Haiti was thrust into the world's spotlight when a 7.0-magnitude earthquake struck in January. Immediately, compassion moved communities and charities to join forces in providing aid to those affected by the tragedy. Already one of the poorest countries in the Western Hemisphere, an estimated 3 million Haitians were affected by this natural disaster that injured over 300,000, killed an estimated 230,000 and left approximately 1 million people homeless.

Countries all around the world responded and people from every walk of life felt the need to do something. Even local schools in the Bloomingdale area began asking, "What can we do?"

The AVID Club at Burns Middle School decided to hold a three-day drive to collect clothing, shoes, water and food. AVID member Tranae' Robinson said, "We wanted to do this because we have friends at school who have family members in Haiti." Motivated to help those friends feel better, Robinson said, "We are all family no matter where we come from."

Madison Roberts, an AVID officer said, "We decided to have a competition between teams for lunch line passes. I was excited to see how fast students at Burns came together in bringing in items to help families in Haiti." The middle school students collected over 6,000

Eating out is one of those things every family cuts back on when money gets tight, but that doesn't mean you can't still dine on restaurant quality meals. All it takes is a great recipe and a pizzazz for presentation to make dinner at home feel like a special occasion.

Chicken Provolone

- 6 boneless, skinless chicken breasts 6 slices provolone cheese
- 2 small cans mushrooms, sliced
- **Curry powder**
- Salt and pepper Offive of

Heat the olive oil in a large non-stick skillet over medium high heat. Sprinkle chicken breasts with salt, pepper and curry powder. Place the seasoned side down in heated skillet. Season the other side. Allow chicken to cook until golden brown, not moving it around and allowing it to sear and get golden brown. Reduce heat to medium if cooking too quickly. Cook for 6 minutes, then turn, again, not moving the chicken around, but allowing it to sear. Cook for another 6 minutes, depending on thickness of chicken breasts, or until done. Remove from skillet onto platter, placing a slice of provolone cheese on top of each piece of chicken. Make an aluminum foil tent and place over chicken, which will allow cheese to melt. In the meantime, over medium heat in same skillet, pour in two cans of mushrooms. undrained. Stir until heated through, picking up pan drippings. You may season these with a little salt and pepper if you'd like. Once they've sautéed, pour them over the chicken and serve with rice or risotto and a vegetable.




