

GARDEN TOUR TIPS

In each future Gazette issue a gardening tip which was discussed on the Garden Tour will appear.

TIP #1 - By far the most asked question was "How do I make my Bahia grass lawn look thick and green?"

Gil's answer was: If you want a thick green lawn which is weed resistant plant/plug/or sod with St. Augustine. His point was that Bahia grass is not a lawn grass & that when treated like a proper lawn grass to be lush & green it develops a susceptability to weeds & disease. In addition, it loses the drought tolerance which makes it so popular for roadsides & pastures.

To control weed in Bahia grass, a standard weed & feed is effective, as is a weed killing spray containing both 2,4-D & DiCambra. Apply both carefully & according to label instructions & when the weeds are actively growing.

BAKED APPLES

Bake 45 minutes at 375'.

6 apples (Granny Smith or Rome)
3/4 to 1 c. sugar or substitute
to taste
2 Tbsp. cinnamon
3/4 c. pecans - chopped
3/4 c. raisins
1/4 c. rum
1 c. white wine

1/4 c. butter or margarine

Mix together sugar, cinnamon, pecans, & raisins. Wash & core apples. Seal bottom of each apple with butter - reserving some to dot on tops. Fill each hole with sugar mixture & place in casserole. Dot each with butter & pour wine & rum over apples. Bake, covered, 45 minutes at 375° or until apples are tender. These may be served with cream or dessert topping.
