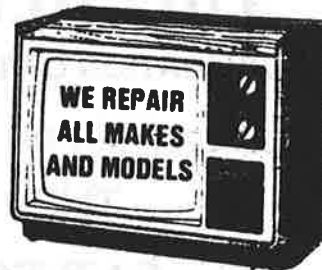

--- SNAKES ---

In our area, with new construction going on, we may see an unusual number of snakes for awhile. But don't let fear of snakes spoil your enjoyment of the Florida outdoors. According to the Florida Cooperative Extension Services, more people are killed in Florida from lightning strikes (12 deaths per year) than from snakebites (2-3 deaths per year). There are about 200-300 snakebite cases recorded in Florida each year, but simple precautions can prevent you and your family from being likely candidates. These include:

- 1.) Look where you step in the woods.
- 2.) Don't place bare hands under rocks, in holes, in hollow logs or under boards, debris or heavy brush (don't keep loose boards etc. laying around your property).
- 3.) When camping, be cautious about sleeping on the ground in the open.
- 4.) Don't walk in the woods barefoot or with light shoes on.
- 5.) Don't pick up freshly killed snakes.
- 6.) Eliminate rats, mice, and cover which might attract snakes.

There are snakeproof fences but these are not seen too often. They slant outward from the bottom to the top at a 30 degree angle.

If by chance you are bitten, the recommended treatment is to get to the nearest hospital as quickly as possible. The cut - and - suction method is currently out of favor. If you are within one hour of medical aid, you don't even have to bother with a tourniquet. It is primarily important to remain calm as the poison is more rapidly spread by a racing heart. If it is possible, bring along the snake that bit you to the hospital.

We have six types of poisonous snakes in Florida. These include the Eastern Diamondback Rattlesnake, the Canebrake Rattlesnake (this one mostly in northern Florida), the Pigmy Rattlesnake (no recorded fatalities from this one), the Cottonmouth Moccasin, the Southern Copperhead (rare - no fatalities), and the Common Coral Snake ("red touches yellow, killa fellow"). There is also a Southern Florida Coral Snake in the Everglades National Park.

Make yourself and your family familiar with how these snakes look. The non-poisonous snakes such as the black racer we see around are actually beneficial in that they keep away the poisonous ones. Being aware when you're outside and ridding your yard of woody and grassy debris are your best bets for snakebite prevention.
