Gil Whitton, host of local radio & television gardening shows, & prominent local horticulturist is coming to Bloomingdale on Saturday, Oct. 23rd, at 10:30 am. Mr. Whitton will conduct a 2 - 3 hour tour of our neighborhood, discussing Florida gardening & answering your questions. This is being sponsored by your Bloomingdale Homeowners' Association.

We plan to make 3 or 4 main tour stops with each made up of 3 or 4 subject yards. This way we can cover a wide area & variety of subjects.

Examples of the type of information you can expect are:

- How to spot & diagnose spider mites on various plants.

- Which Juniper are the hardiest.

- How to prune & care for your young trees.
- What to spray your lawn with to get rid of the weeds.

- Which trees in your yard you can expect to die within 5 - 7 years.
- What plants will tolerate the cold, which ones to cover.

- What trees to plant for rapid growth & maximum shade.


