Have you noticed the palm trees, oak trees, benches, landscaped common areas and the sprinkler systems around Bloomingdale? These are but a part of what the Special Taxing District (STD) does for the fortunate people who call Bloomingdale "home." With an annual budget of over \$300,000, administered by a seven-person Board of Trustees, the STD meets monthly to discuss and adjust the Master Plan for our community. Extensive work on the major entryways will be completed by 1999 at a cost of \$20-30,000 per site.

Bloomingdale Mobile Watch is another organization that serves our residents. Composed of volunteers, Mobile Watch's vehicles patrol major thoroughfares, small streets and dead ends-everywhere-to deter crime and provide a presence that makes Bloomingdale show one of the lowest statistical crime rates in Hillsborough County.

A third organization that supports Bloomingdale is the

Community Concerns:

The litter problem

LITTER has infiltrated and continues to corrupt our community at an alarming rate! All the paper, cans and bottles did not fly onto the common areas of Bloomingdale East and West, so who keeps putting it there? The litter apparently multiplies and refuses to relinquish its hold, no matter how thorough our cleaning strategies may be.

The Bloomingdale Special
Taxing District has the litter picked
up on Mondays and Fridays, plus
the maintenance contractor picks up
as they mow the area and still the
litter is there. Three times a week is
needed to basically keep the area
presentable.

Every month, 35-40, 30 gallon trash bags of litter are removed from the 13 miles of common area. Some interesting data: of the beer cans distributed and flung about in the area, Bud outnumbers the rest, with Miller Lite and Busch trailing very close behind; the discarded beer bottle division is headed by Bud Lite, Corona and Heineken; alcoholic spirits have a strong showing of their own, with gin and vodka apparently the most popular among litterbugs. McDonald's leads the fast food category, with Taco Bell trash and Wendy's refuse following closely behind. Coke, Pepsi and Surge are the most common soft drink cans to be found littered about. Kent, Winston and Salem cigarette packages are more prevalent than are Marlboro and Camel. Old tires, toilet bowls, diapers, hubcaps and various articles of apparel are a few more interesting items that have been abandoned and retrieved around the community. As an additional incentive, perhaps, and to keep things interesting, a little cash has been found and

has been returned to circulation.

As you can see, there is a real problem with litter in our subdivision. People don't think twice about rolling down the windows and throwing out whatever they have finished. This makes a real mess for everyone and devalues our neighborhood. The Bloomingdale Special Taxing District works very hard to enhance the appearance of the common areas which, in turn, helps to increase the property value of our homes. However, the litter problem is a constant, very avoidable nuisance which takes money out of our other programs.



Bloomingdale Homeowners Association (BHA). This voluntary group, asking only a \$20 annual donation from families, maintains projects like continued publication of the Gazette, the Deed Restriction Enforcement Program, the Santa Comes to Bloomingdale Program, the Neighborhood Involvement Program (NIP) which protects property values by helping the county enforce County Codes and the funding for the Mobile Watch Program. The BHA also works with the County Government for improved services like sidewalks, street lighting and road signs. It was instrumental in building the Community Center in Park West and, recently, adding the lights to Park East.

Finally, the fourth supporting organization is the Bloomingdale Gazette: the monthly newspaper that you are now reading. This paper is owned by the BHA which makes every dues-paying member of our community an "owner." For almost 15 years, the

Gazette has rallied residents to impending problems (like a proposed carwash for Nature's Way which was withdrawn when the potential owner became aware of its unpopularity), pushed for the widening of Bloomingdale Avenue and kept residents informed of the happenings and achievements so crucial to our public who has the right to know.




